Please note that the enrolments for the new intake of P1 children takes place week beginning 13<sup>th</sup> January for children who are 5 years of age between 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020 and the end of February 2021. Monday  $13^{th}$ , Tuesday  $14^{th}$  and Friday  $17^{th}$  January from 8:30am-10:30am AND 2pm-4pm.

If you have any difficulties coming within these times, please telephone the school and we will do our best to accommodate you. Remember to bring along your child's **full birth** certificate and two proofs of address. Please note, it must be the parent or legal guardian who comes to enrol.
