Thursday 9th May- Yellow and Green Teams (Counting & Number Recognition)


Thursday 23rd May- ALL TEAMS (final evaluative session)

ELC Improvement Plan- Self-Evaluation

As part of our Improvement Plan this session, the staff team are actively involved in self-evaluation and identifying areas for improvement. We are involving all stakeholders in our self-evaluation and emailed out a questionnaire in December for all parents/ carers to complete. Thank you to all those who completed this as your views are very important to us as we strive to provide the best care possible to our learners and families. Here are the results:

1. My child feels nurtured and cared for by staff.

92.3% Excellent 7.7% Very Good

2. The staff know my child well and know what is important to them.

ELC Lending Library

Our school and ELC are continuing to focus on Reading. This involves fostering an enjoyment of reading across the ELC and school and encouraging good reading habits.
