## New Tracking Sheets

We have introduced new skills tracking sheets for every child in the playroom, focusing on Numeracy, Literacy and Health and Wellbeing. These focus on progress over time and staff will use a coloured system to show this. Practitioners will indicate progress within each statement using a colour coded system as follows:

<u>Red (Introduced)</u> - Your child has had the opportunity to learn in this area through **a variety of opportunities and experiences**. To record this, a red dot will be placed at the beginning of the statement to record progress.

<u>Yellow (Progressing)</u> - If your child can respond to a level of challenge in the experience and is moving forward in this statement, the 'I can/know/understand' will be highlighted in yellow to record progress.

<u>Green (Competent)</u> - If your child **can apply what they have learned in new learning opportunities across the curriculum**, the whole statement will be fully highlighted green to indicate they have demonstrated competence. When it is highlighted green, this will be dated with the month and year e.g. Nov '18
