# Wellbeing Indicator of the Month - Healthy

Every month we will introduce/reinforce one of the areas which helps our children explore their wellbeing and how this can be improved or supported. This month's focus is on HEALTHY which includes healthy eating, hygiene, taking regular exercise and getting plenty of rest.



### Forest Kindergarten

We are really excited that Miss Elkin, our Forest School Leader, will soon be starting up sessions in our school woods with the children. We believe that the outdoor environment has massive potential for pre-school learning, offering motivating, exciting, creative, challenging and relevant learning experiences. Outdoor learning experiences are often remembered for a lifetime and provide relevance and depth to the curriculum in ways that are difficult to achieve indoors. Outdoor learning also connects children with the outdoor world and offers opportunities for personal and learning skills development in areas such as communication, problem solving, teamwork and resilience.

Forest Kindergarten will commence on **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November** and last for four Wednesdays, with the last session taking place on **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> November**. Children should dress appropriately for their visits to the woods e.g. warm clothing, long sleeved tops, waterproof jackets/trousers, hats, scarves, gloves and wellies. We have a limited supply of waterproofs and wellies, so we can help out if needed. Your child will enjoy the freedom to participate in adventurous play, take and manage risk, challenge themselves physically and most importantly, HAVE FUN! They will have the opportunity to learn about safety around a small campfire, cook outdoors and use tools safely under the close supervision of our staff team. We would like to invite you to a Forest Kindergarten information session on **Wednesday 30th October at 9am or 3:15pm**, depending on which session your child attends.
