- ✓ Support learners to deal positively with changes in routines- managing these changes with resilience
- ✓ Support them in their back to school/ELC friendships and relationships with staff
- ✓ Increase physical activity and health
- ✓ Mitigate the risks and ensure all guidance from SLC and Public Health is followed to ensure staff and learners are safe
- ✓ Provide emotional wellbeing support for all staff, learners and families
- ✓ Alleviate anxieties for families by providing a clear sense of direction with effective communication in place to share our infection control and safety measures

Equity

Together with pupils, parents and staff we will make decisions about the most appropriate interventions and approaches to be used to help close the 'poverty' related attainment gap.

- ✓ Establish current 'gaps', including access to Digital Learning at home
- ✓ Identify resources needed
- ✓ Focussed approaches to Literacy, Numeracy and Health and Wellbeing
- ✓ To support staff expertise, parental engagement and increase access to appropriate interventions for learners
- ✓ Plan 'universal' and 'targeted' support to help narrow 'identified' gaps
- ✓ Ensure there is a clear policy to limit 'The Cost of the School Day'
- ✓ Promote emotional and social wellbeing for staff, learners, parents/carers and the wider community



- ✓ Establish clear procedures for Online Learning- Google Classroom for P1-7 and through emails for learners in the ELC.
- ✓ Over time, ensure equal access to digital devices and an online network
- ✓ Provide ICT guidance and support for staff, learners and parents/carers
- ✓ Agree clear guidance for teachers to ensure consistency of learning
- ✓ Provide high quality learning and teaching which ensures the needs of all learners are met
- ✓ Ensure learners can play, learn and access experiences that meet their physical, social, emotional and cultural needs
