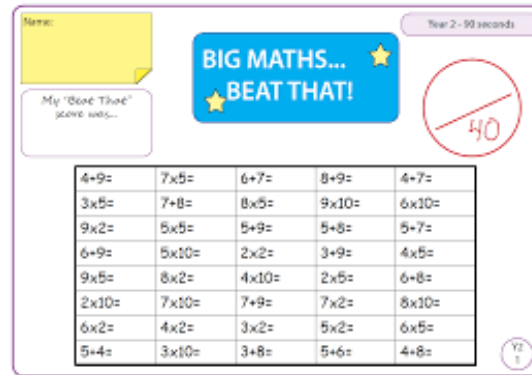


Numeracy

To develop literacy skills with a particular focus on developing phonological awareness (ELC)

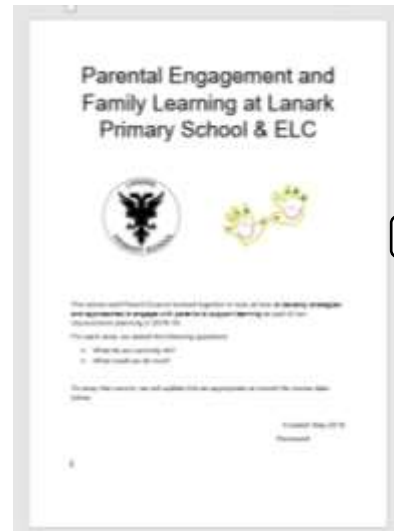
