

Numeracy

Pupils will be working on using written and mental strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems within 100. They will also work on being able to quickly recall all subtraction and addition facts within 20 using Big Maths resources. They will have the opportunity to use coordinate grids and will learn how to describe journeys using compass points. During our Christmas art activities the pupils will be learning about lines of symmetry and symmetrical patterns.

Homework

Homework will be issued on a Monday via Google Classroom and is due back on the Friday. This is designed to give pupils the opportunity to consolidate their daily learning. Activities will include:

- Spelling
- Reading
- Big Maths
- Numeracy/Maths
- Talking and Listening

Literacy

Children will continue to work on our spelling and phonics programme and will complete daily grammar and writing tasks related to their reading books. As we approach Christmas they will be exploring Christmas stories and poetry as well as descriptive writing.

French

Children will use French daily. They will continue to learn greetings, numbers, colours, days of the week and months of the year. They will also be learning how to describe the weather in French.

Topic

We will be continuing our work on Scotland's landscape and will be using the Katie Morag stories to encourage reading, comprehension and social studies.

Science

This term Primary 3 will we are learning to describe the position and function of the skeleton and major organs of the human body and discuss what we need to do to keep them healthy.

RME

The pupils will be considering their own beliefs and values as we explore the nativity story and the key values of Christmas and other religious festivals. They will learn about Winter Customs and Traditions around the world.
