Maths

Pupils will be working on place value at the beginning of the term at their own level. We will focus on rounding, partitioning and ordering numbers. We will then move onto addition and subtraction where we will develop our number skills in this area by working on both written and mental strategies. On Thursdays, Ms Raeside will be working with the children on Data Handling. This will involve learning new ways to collect, collate and present information, including the use of technology, in clear and organised manners.

Health and Wellbeing

We will be working collaboratively to explore our rights as children. Our class charter, which we will create together, will remind us to be respectful of each other in the classroom and throughout the school. We will be working through "Protective Behaviours" which is a programme for children to explore feeling and being safe. We will further explore our feelings and emotions while emphasising the importance of considering those of others.

Religious and Moral Education
