Numeracy

Pupils will have many opportunities to count, match, write, describe and compare numbers relevant to their stage. The class will focus on solving addition and subtraction problems using a variety of strategies. All pupils will have the opportunity to develop their numeracy and math skills through play based and outdoor activities. P2/1 will focus on quick recall of number facts and solving problems in a 'real life' context.

<u>Science</u>

This term Primary 2/1 will consider what it means to 'be alive'.

<u>French</u>

Pupils will practise daily the days, date, months and weather in French. They will listen and respond to daily routines such as line up, push in you chairs, ordering lunch and using good manners.

<u>Literacy</u>

Pupils will work through the phonics and spelling programme relevant to their stage.

Pupils will receive 1-2 taught writing lessons per week.

Pupils will work through the reading programme in accordance with their readiness to read and developing skills.

Health and Wellbeing

Throughout this term pupils will begin to explore their feelings and emotions. In PE they will develop striking and ball handling skills through club golf and will take part in athletic activities in the MUGA.

As a class we will also create our Class Charter in line with UNC Children's Rights, the school's values and skills for life, learning and work.

<u>Topic</u>

During this term pupils will be developing the following skills through 'The Magic Toymaker' storyline.

- Learn that investigating artefacts help us understand the past.
- Use the internet to research the past and discuss how some evidence is more useful than others
- Identify and understand the differences between our lives and those of people who have lived in the past.
