

## Numeracy

In Numeracy, pupils will be working on Addition and Subtraction. Pupils will work at the appropriate stage and pace for them. They will work on:

- *Solving addition and subtraction problems involving up to 6 digits using written and mental strategies.*
- *adding and subtract mentally up to 2 decimal places e.g.  $6.09 + 1.97$*
- Use calculators to add and subtract.

In Maths, pupils will continue their learning on measurement in order to:

- *find the volume of cubes and cuboids using the formula ( $V = L \times B \times H$ )*
- Revise the relationships: 1 litre, half-litre,  $\frac{1}{4}l$ ,  $\frac{3}{4}l$  and the relationships with ml
- converting from l and ml to ml and vice versa e.g.  $5l\ 358ml = 5358ml$

Learners should practice their 'Learn Its' regularly at home. This will support their Multiplication and Division work next term.

## Health and Wellbeing

This term we will continue to work through our Emotion Works programme. We will explore the behaviours people show when they are feeling a variety of emotions and how to recognise our own patterns of behaviour.

We will also be exploring the Well Being Indicators of Achieving and Nurtured.

In PE, we will be working on both Possession and Target Games. In particular, we will be focusing on developing our use of strategy and communication in team games.

We will also be in the woodlands for outdoor learning most Tuesdays.

## Science

Pupils will be learning about Earth's Forces and will then be exploring electrical circuits.

## Modern Languages

Pupils will be learning to count up to 100 in French and BSL this term. They will also be increasing their confidence when fingerspelling in BSL.

## RME

Pupils will be learning about key events in a Christian's life (birth, marriage and death). They will also be participating in Christmas themed activities throughout December.

## Literacy

This term, pupils will continue to work through our spelling programmes at their appropriate level. Our target is to use all previously learned spelling words and common words in our written tasks across the curriculum. Learners are also engaging in dictionary tasks to build confidence when checking spelling of unfamiliar words.

In writing, pupils will be focusing on creating texts for a range of purposes. They will be focusing on narrative writing and discursive writing. For narrative writing, they will analyse popular children's picture books to identify their features (e.g. repetition, rhyme) before creating their own winter-themed story. For discursive writing, pupils will create a balanced argument with evidence to support each argument.

In Listening and Talking, pupils are developing their ability to listen for a sustained period of time. We will be developing this using a range of children's podcasts and other supporting resources.
