## Maths

#### Decimals

- Work with decimals to three decimal places including rounding
- Multiply and divide decimals mentally

#### Percentages

- Use mental and written methods to find simple percentages of quantities, e.g. 10%, 25%, 50%
- Use the equivalent forms of simple fractions, decimal fractions and percentages in calculations, e.g.  $\frac{1}{4}$  = 25%= 0.25,  $\frac{1}{2}$  = 50% = 0.5
- Demonstrate their understanding of the relationship between fractions, decimal fractions and percentages

#### Multiples, factors, Primes

- Can use the terms multiple, factor, square number and prime in the correct context.
- Can identify multiples, factors, primes, square • numbers and square roots of a given number.

Pupils will continue to engage with 'Big Maths' on a daily basis in order to increase their speed and accuracy when recalling tables facts.
