Numeracy

Data and Analysis

Children will be able to:

- Read and interpret bar charts, pie charts, line graphs and trend graphs.
- Use IT to display the results of a survey using tables, bar graphs, databases, bar graphs, spreadsheets and line graphs.
- Use a variety of methods to gather data, e.g. observations, surveys, questionnaires, experiments
- Recognise when presentation is misleading and discuss possible causes for this.

Pupils will continue to engage with 'Big Maths' on a daily basis in order to increase their speed and accuracy when recalling tables facts. Problem solving skills will be visited throughout the term with the focus being on solving problems in a 'real life' context.
