Pupils will be learning to:

Place Value & Decimals

- Understand place & value up to 6 digits and 3 decimal places.
- For some; understand place & value up to 9 digits and 3 decimal places.
- Use formal methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication & division to calculate decimal sums.
- Build their knowledge of mental maths strategies & apply in problem solving examples.
- Apply partitioning strategies & the formal method with decimal sums to make money calculations.

Measurement

- Recognise and order metric measurements.
- Apply decimal learning to convert metric measurements

Multiples, Factors and Primes

- Recognise number patterns in and beyond all multiplication tables. (Learn Its CLIC)
- Identify some multiples, factors, square numbers and square roots.

Health and Wellbeing

Pupils will engage with the '8 Wellbeing Indicators' & our 'Emotion Works' cogs and will explore how the indicators can help to keep on top of their social, emotional and physical wellbeing. Pupils will focus on skills such as: team work & coordination during both indoor and outdoor PE sessions. Our focus in Health & Wellbeing will be on protective behaviours through which children will be encouraged to think about a range of emotions and how to identify them in themselves.
