

Literacy

Pupils will continue to work through the phonics and spelling programme relevant to their stage.

Pupils will receive 1-2 taught writing lessons per week and have been focussing on ensuring we always have capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our written work. We are learning to add more detail into our writing by using connectives and adjectives.

As a class, we are all focusing on our handwriting and correct letter formation.

Pupils will continue to work through the reading programme in accordance with their readiness to read and developing skills.

ICT

Pupils will have the opportunity to use the Chromebooks and iPads to develop skills taught in class.

Health and Wellbeing

This term our HWB indicators are Safe and Healthy. This will be explored through P.E, healthy lifestyles and food and health.

During outdoor and indoor PE, we will be working on both possession and target games. Through a variety of games, we will be learning to develop an understanding of our role in a team to support each other and help the performance of the whole team. We will also develop an understanding for rules in games.

Numeracy

Pupils will be working on numbers to 100. They will look at writing, counting (forwards and backwards) and ordering numbers.

We will also be learning about Time. Pupils will work to further develop their skills telling o'clock and half past times on digital and analogue clocks. They will have opportunities to use a calendar to plan and organise key events and pupils will begin to develop a sense of how long tasks take by measuring the time taken to complete a range of activities.

Pupils will also focus on quick recall of number facts through our Big Maths activities. Our Main focus this term will be counting in 5s and number bonds to 10.
