<u>Literacy</u> Pupils will continue to work through the phonics and spelling programme relevant to their stage.

Pupils will receive 1-2 taught writing lessons per week and have been focussing on ensuring we always have capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our written work. We are learning to add more detail into our writing by using connectives and adjectives.

As a class, we are all focusing on our handwriting and correct letter formation.

Pupils will continue to work through the reading programme in accordance with their readiness to read and developing skills.

Health and Wellbeing

This term our HWB indicators are Safe and Healthy. This will be explored through P.E, healthy lifestyles and food and health.

During outdoor and indoor PE, we will be working on both possession and target games. Pupils are developing their throwing, catching and passing skills to use in a variety of games. When playing these games, we will be learning to develop an understanding of our role in a

team to support each other and help the performance of the whole team. We will also develop an understanding for rules in games. <u>PE days are:</u> Tuesday (MUGA) Wednesday (Indoor gym hall)

Our Woodlands slot is a Friday. Appropriate clothing is required for all sessions.





<u>Topic</u>

This term children will explore 'Under the Sea' and the creatures that live there. The pupils will learn about the different oceans and will explore different climate zones around the world. We will then look to compare and describe how climate affects living things and consider ways of looking after and caring for their environment.

<u>R.M.E</u>

This term our focus will be on Christianity. Pupils will have the opportunity to learn about the Christmas story and compare Christian traditions to others across the world.

<u>Science - Miss Forbes</u> The pupils are learning what it means to be alive and what living things need to survive.

Numeracy

This term pupils will be working on numbers to 100. They will look at writing, counting (forwards and backwards) and ordering numbers.

We will also be learning about Time. Pupils will work to further develop their skills telling o'clock and half past times on digital and analogue clocks.

Pupils will have opportunities to use a calendar to plan and organise key events and will begin to develop a sense of how long tasks take by measuring the time taken to complete a range of activities.

Pupils will also focus on quick recall of number facts through our Big Maths Learn Its and activities. Our Main focus this term will be counting in 5s and number bonds to 10.

<u>French and British Sign Language</u> Pupils will have the opportunity to learn the French vocabulary and British Sign language for greetings, number and weather this term. Our class is also responsible for the French phrase of the week at assembly.

ICT

Pupils will have the opportunity to use the Chromebooks and iPads to develop continue to develop their ICT skills taught in class.
