This term, we have been working on addition and subtraction skills. The pupils have been using various materials such as Numicon, cubes and number squares to aid with this. We have also been learning how to use word problems to relate maths to real life.

In December, the class will be moving onto to learn about angles and direction where we will learn how to give and follow directions to meet various destinations.

Each Friday, we complete our Big Maths Beat That Challenges within the class. We practise our mental maths and answer quick fire questions to beat our previous scores.

## Topic

## Literacy

During our taught writing sessions we will focus on functional writing genres such as instructions and letter writing.

During our reading sessions, we have been focusing on the introduction, problem and resolution of a story and how this helps to us to better understand the story. We have also been using prediction to guess what might happen in our books.
