

Literacy

Pupils will continue to work through the phonics and spelling programme relevant to their stage.

Pupils will receive 1-2 taught writing lessons per week and will be working on writing instructions and information reports. We will continue to focus on using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces as well as using verbs and personal pronouns in our Grammar work.

Pupils will continue to work through the reading programme at their level with a focus on fluency and expression when reading aloud. We will have a focus on predictions and connections as a reading skill.

ICT

Pupils will have the opportunity to use the Chromebooks and iPads to develop skills taught in class.

Science

Pupils will be exploring the structure and function of the sensory organs.

Numeracy

Pupils will continue to work on addition and subtraction to 20 in an active way. We will be working on missing number calculations and counting on and back strategies.

We will continue to work on numbers to 100. Pupils will have the opportunity to order numbers and explore ordinal numbers.

Pupils will also be learning about collecting, sorting and displaying data in a variety of ways including bar charts and Venn diagrams.

Pupils will also focus on quick recall of number facts through our Big Maths.
