Numeracy

Pupils will work at the appropriate stage and pace for them whilst developing their knowledge of place value. P3 pupils will be working with numbers up to 1,000 and P2 pupils will be working on numbers up to 100. We will be looking at reading, writing, comparing and ordering these numbers. Learning will then be moving on to addition and subtraction at their own appropriate level.

We will also be using grid references and following directions using left and right as this will be linked to our Katie Morag topic.

Health and Wellbeing

This term we will continue working on our Protective Behaviours programme. Pupils will be exploring the ways in which we can keep ourselves and others safe. We will also be learning about where to find help if you need it and using kind words and actions both inside and out of school.

In PE, we will be working on both possession and target games. We will particularly be focusing on what makes a good team player and how to encourage others.

We will also be in the woodlands for outdoor learning most Tuesdays. Appropriate clothing is required for all sessions.

Topic

We will soon be starting our new topic based on Scotland's landscape and will be using the Katie Morag stories to encourage reading, comprehension and social studies.
