Numeracy

Pupils will work at the appropriate stage and pace for them whilst developing their knowledge of addition and subtraction. We will be working on calculations within 100. We will be working on quick recall and Big Maths 'learn-it's' facts and mental maths activities.

Pupils will continue to consolidate their number work including place value and counting in 2,5,10's.

During our Christmas art activities, the pupils will be learning about lines of symmetry and symmetrical patterns.


Health and Wellbeing

Our learning in Health and Wellbeing this term will be focussed on similarity, diversity and respect, and 'all families are different'. We will discuss the green and red cog for our Emotion Works work, which are emotions behaviours and sensations.

In PE, we will be working on target and team games. We will continue to focus on encouraging others and providing constructive feedback to peers.

<u>PE days are</u>: Monday (Indoor gym hall) Friday (MUGA)

We will also be in the woodlands for Outdoor Learning most Thursdays. Appropriate clothing is required for all sessions.





<u>RME</u>

The pupils will be considering their own beliefs and values as we explore different Christmas and other religious traditions around the world. They will learn about Winter Customs and traditions from around the world.

Christmas 'Foodraiser'

Pupils will be responsible for organising the school's Christmas food bank. The class have launched the campaign through their Pupil Leadership Team. They will work together to collect and organise the donations into bags. We are excited to see how many food bags we can make up to help our school community!

<u>Science</u>

In Science we are working on our knowledge of energy, specifically food as an energy source. This will include looking at healthy eating and benefits of healthy foods.

Modern Languages

In French pupils will be learning Christmas vocabulary and classroom objects. Pupils will learn about numbers and calendar as well as Christmas signs in BSL

<u>Literacy</u>

This term, pupils will continue to work through our spelling programmes at their appropriate level. Spelling activities are completed daily, and learners are expected to apply this learning consistently in their writing tasks. As a class, we are all focusing on our handwriting and correct letter formation.

In writing lessons, pupils will be focusing on creating texts for a range of purposes. This will include writing letters and postcards to convey information. Pupils will also be focussing on including elements of VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation) in their imaginative story writing.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework will be issued on a Monday via Google Classroom and is due back on Friday. This will give pupils the opportunity to consolidate their daily learning. We will also be using Easimaths and Reading Eggs in our homework, which will be linked through Google Classroom.
