### <u>Numeracy</u>

Pupils will work at the appropriate stage and pace for them whilst developing their knowledge of place value. We will be working on comparing and ordering numbers, as well as reading and writing them in various ways e.g., word form, partitioning.

Our learning will include addition and subtraction at the appropriate level, and working on our mental agility e.g., fast fact recall.

We will be working on measure as it will link with our Vikings topic.

## Health and Wellbeing

Our learning in Health and Wellbeing this term will be focussed on feelings and safety. We will work to understand our feelings and how we express them and will be looking into keeping and feeling safe. We will be working with emotion works to support this.
