

Numeracy

Pupils will work at the appropriate stage and pace for them whilst exploring addition and subtraction. P3 pupils will be working on calculations within 100 and P2 pupils will be working on calculations up to 20. They will also be working on their quick recall of their Big Maths 'Learn Its' facts.

We will be working on grid references through our Katie Morag topic and using compass points for directions. 2D and 3D shapes will also be taught through junk modelling, art and structured play activities.

Health and Wellbeing

This term we will continue to work through our Emotion Works programme. We will explore the vocabulary that we use to describe different emotions and the ways in which our behaviours indicate how we are feeling. We will also be covering the Well Being Indicators of Achieving and Nurtured.

In PE, we will be working on target and team games. We will continue to focus on encouraging others and providing constructive feedback to peers.

ICT

Pupils continue to develop their ICT skills and will be practising logging on independently to Google Classroom, Reading Eggs and RM EasiMaths.

In writing lessons, pupils will be focusing on creating texts for a range of purposes. This will include writing letters and postcards to convey information. Pupils will also be focusing on including elements of VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation) in their imaginative story writing.
