Numeracy

Our current focus in Numeracy is Place Value. P4 will be working with numbers up to 10,000 and P5 will be working with digits up to 1 million. Our work will concentrate on writing, ordering and comparing, and partitioning these numbers. We will also learn about estimating using a number line and rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

Learning will then continue on to the core operation of addition. Our main focus during this block of work will be developing our confidence using the standard column written method.


A real-life context will be used wherever possible to aid our learning in Numeracy.
