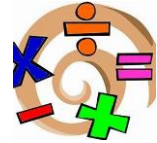


Numeracy

Children will be able to:



Multiplication and Division

- Use table facts (2-10) and a variety of mental methods to work out multiplication calculations.
- Lay out and complete multiplication and division including remainders using both written formats.
- Can use practical materials and/or multiplication tables to find related "families" of four facts

2D Shapes and 3D Objects

- Can explore properties of different pyramids and prisms including triangular based pyramid.
- Can sort 3D shapes by property
- Can recognise shapes that are regular and irregular

Pupils will continue to engage with 'Big Maths' to increase their speed and accuracy when recalling tables and number bond facts. Problem solving skills will be visited throughout the term.

ICT

Children will continue to use Chromebooks and class computers on a weekly basis to develop their ICT skills. Children will develop their word processing skills using Google Docs. Children will continue to use the website 'Reading Eggs' as part of their weekly Literacy programme.

RME

Children will be learning about Hinduism and Diwali as well as learning about the Christmas story and the true meaning of Christmas.

French

Pupils will learn about French parts of the body and clothing. We will also learn the vocabulary relating to French food and drink this term as well as consolidating basic greetings, numbers, days of the week and months of the year. Children will design a French menu whilst also learning some 'festive' words and phrases.



Science (with Ms Forbes)

In Science, the children will be learning about different types of energy and their importance to everyday life.

Literacy

This term, pupils will be reading a group text in class and will undertake tasks related to their reading focussing on: predicting, summarising, determining importance and inferring.

During our taught writing sessions children will be learning to use discursive and persuasive language as well as writing for functional purposes, such as letters and instructions.



Weekly spelling rules and grammar lessons will also feature. Children should continue with a personal reader at home. This does not need to be novels - recipes, news articles and magazines are all valuable texts to be reading! Children are welcome to borrow books from the class/ school libraries too!

Health and Wellbeing

Pupils will continue to engage with the 'Emotion Works' programme, our whole school approach to emotional learning and wellbeing. Children will develop their emotional language and understanding through engaging with each of the coloured 'cogs' which represent things such as: emotional triggers, emotion words and body sensations. P.E times will provide children with the opportunity to develop their teamwork and communication skills through team games.
