# Numeracy

Our current focus in Numeracy is Subtraction. During this block of work we will be developing our confidence using the standard written column method. This will include the concept of borrowing. We will also learn some mental strategies that we can use to support with our work on subtraction.

Learning will then move to 2D and 3D Shape and Symmetry. We will learn the properties of shapes and how these can be used to help with identification. Symmetry will be investigated with a little help of Christmas magic!

A real-life context will be used wherever possible to aid our learning in Numeracy.



We will continue to engage with our weekly Big Maths CLICS and Learn Its to develop our quick-fire recall of times tables and number bond facts.

# Social Studies

We are continuing our work on our topic, The Film Industry, this term.



We will learn about some of the roles within the industry, such as costume and set designers, and we will have a go at trying them for ourselves. We will also think about the skillset required for these roles and whether they are useful for other jobs and industries.

As part of our learning, we will collaborate to create short films of our own. This will allow us to put some of the things we have learned into practice.
