#### **Numeracy**

Pupils will be exploring place value this term. They will be learning to identify the value of a digit in a number, as well as partitioning and ordering numbers. We will also learn to estimate and round numbers. We will then move onto addition. Pupils will be learning to solve addition problems involving up to 5 digits using written and mental strategies. Pupils will have opportunities to solve problems and apply their learning to real life concepts.

#### **Science**

In Primary 5 pupils will be learning about animal habitats.

# <u>Topic</u>

We will be finding out about The Egyptians this term. We will be participating in a range of activities across the curriculum to explore Ancient Egypt including subjects such as art, ICT and writing. Pupils will have opportunities to research areas of this topic which interest them during this term.

# <u>ICT</u>

Pupils will practise logging on to glow to use RM Easimaths and Microsoft office programmes on the ChromeBook. We will develop our research skills using internet searches and use a variety of Microsoft Office programmes to present our findings.

## **Literacy**

Pupils will be working through the spelling programme and will have opportunities to develop their understanding on a daily basis.. Pupils will explore the phonemes using a range of approaches including elkonin boxes, diacritical marking and phoneme stories.

We will be looking at instructional writing, report writing and imaginative writing. Pupils will practise assessing and editing their writing and looking for areas to improve using VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation).

Pupils will have opportunities for both personal and group reading. We will use a range of strategies to develop our comprehension skills. We will have lots of opportunities to read aloud to develop our fluency.

#### Health and Wellbeing

At Lanark Primary School, we strive to ensure all children support the values that are important to our school. We have worked together to create a class charter which reflects both our school values and rights. We are working hard to follow the rules of our Class Charter.

During this term, pupils will explore their feelings and emotions. They will consider how to deal with these feelings and how to support others around them.
