

Numeracy

In Numeracy, we will develop our understanding and application of multiplication and division. We will work hard to improve both our written and mental strategies to solve calculations.

We are also learning about data handling, angles and coordinates. Pupils will learn about right angles, acute angles and obtuse angles and they will have the opportunity to identify these within our environment. They will also learn to measure and draw angles. We will explore co-ordinates and learn how to plot points on a grid. Pupils will learn to gather data and to display their findings in a range of ways. They will explore line graphs, bar graphs, Venn diagrams and Carroll diagrams.

Topic

This term we will be learning about the rainforest. We will be focussing on the similarities and differences between the LPS forest and the rainforest.

We will also learn about:

- Rainforest locations and climate
- Animal and plant species
- The importance of the rainforest to our lives and our planet
- Deforestation

Health and Wellbeing

During this term, pupils will explore the Blue (regulation strategies) and Grey (intensity) Cogs as part of their Emotion Works learning. We will explore the wellbeing indicators of Respect and Responsible. Pupils will consider stereotypes and develop their understanding of equality. They will also focus on internet safety.
