Pupils will be learning to:

#### <u>Place Value</u>

- Understand place & value up to 6 digits and 3 decimal places. (P6)
- Understand place & value up to 9 digits and 3 decimal places. (P7)
- Revise formal methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication & division.
- Build their knowledge of mental maths strategies.

#### Multiples, Factors and Primes

- Recognise number patterns in and beyond all multiplication tables.
- Identify some multiples, factors, square numbers and square roots.

#### Health and Wellbeing

In PE sessions both indoors and outdoors, we will be developing skills such as co-ordination, team work, perseverance, communication skills and following instructions through the 'Better Movers Thinkers' approach.

As well as P.E, our focus for Health & Wellbeing will be on emotional literacy. Pupils will be encouraged engage with the 8 'Wellbeing Indicators' to consider a wide range of emotions and ways in which to deal with such feelings and emotions. As a class we will be working collaboratively to create our class charter taking into account the United Nations Convention on the Rights of

the Child.
