Numeracy

Pupils will be able to:

- Read, write and order numbers up to 9
 digits (Algebros), up to 8 digits
 (Mathmagicans), 6 digits (Number Wizards)
 and 4/5 digits (Shining Stars).
- Round whole numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. Alegbros will also round whole numbers to the nearest 10,000 and 100,000.
- Develop their multiplication recall of all times tables.
- Read and record digital and analogue time.
- Convert between 12hr and 24hr time.
- Recall units of time
 e.g. 60 seconds = 1 minute, 60 mins= 1 hour
- Recall calendar facts e.g. order of months, number of days in each month, monthly events
