

Numeracy

Pupils will be able to:

- Understand place value of numbers up to 9 digits and 3 decimal places (Algebras), up to 8 digits and 2 decimal places (Squadrilaterals) and 4 digits (Mathletes).
- Round 5-digit and 6-digit numbers to the nearest 1000, 10,000 & 100,000 (P7) and 4-digit numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 (P6).
- Solve addition and subtraction problems involving up to 6-digits (P7) and 5-digits (P6) using written and mental strategies.
- Use all coins and notes, and be able to compare costs.
- Solve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division calculations involving money amounts (decimal point sums).
- Revise reading digital and analogue time and converting between 12hr and 24hr time.
- Calculate complex time durations.

Health and Wellbeing

Across the year, pupils will engage with the 8 Wellbeing Indicators. This term we will focus on the indicators Safe, Healthy, Achieving and Nurtured. In P.E., we will be participating in team games and possession games including Netball and Rugby.

Spelling: Complete an Active Spelling task with your wordlist in your homework jotter weekly.

Reading: Complete 20 minutes of LESSONS on Reading Eggs (3 times a month) & reading comprehension task (once a month).

Numeracy: 1 task to be completed on Google Slides, Docs or Forms and to be submitted on Google Classroom (3 times a month). 20 minutes of RM Easimaths (once a month, but can be used more if you wish). Weekly practice of Big Maths Learn Its.

R.M.E: Our topic will be about Homelessness.

ICT: Pupils shall develop their knowledge and skills of using different G Suite Tools. Pupils will begin to complete projects using Micro:bits.

Literacy & Languages

Spelling: Pupils will focus on a spelling rule each week.

Reading: P7s will finish their book study of 'Divided City' by Theresa Breslin. P6s will finish their book study of 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo. Pupils will then progress onto reading group novels with a focus on enhancing their inference, metalinguistic and visualising skills. Pupils should continue to improve their reading fluency and expression.

Writing: Pupils will write a personal recount every week through 'Weekend News'. Taught writing sessions will focus on Narrative and Information writing.

BSL: Pupils will learn to sign the days of the week, seasons, numbers to 50 and the BSL alphabet.

French: Pupils will revise the days of the week, months of the year, seasons, weather and numbers to 50.
