As of 31st March 2020, we had £3649.63 in the bank.

We have had 8 fundraising events this year:

We should also have had our Bingo Night in March, but that was postponed due to Coronavirus.

In total, we have raised £9348.63 with expenses of £3072.74, leaving a balance of £6275.89.
