Numeracy

Pupils will work at the appropriate stage and pace for them whilst developing their knowledge of multiplication and division. We will be working on using these skills to learn about money as well. Our learning will include working on our mental agility e.g., fast fact recalls of addition, subtraction and multiplication facts.

In mathematics, we will be learning about shape, money (as above), measure and information handling. These will link with our Farm to Fork topic for this term.

Health and Wellbeing

Our learning in Health and Wellbeing this term will be focussed on similarity, diversity and respect. We will work to understand our similarities and differences, what makes us unique and how to respect differences in others.

In P.E, we will be working on central ball and net games (volleyball, badminton), as well as dance. We will be continuing to 'fine tune" our gross motor skills and ability to work in teams.

Topic

We have recently started our new topic 'Farm to Fork'. As a class we are working on our understanding of where our food comes from as well as some aspects of farm life. We will be linking lots of our other learning with our topic!

ICT
