Numeracy

This term our focus will be on multiplication and division. We will work on quick recall of multiplication table facts and associated division calculations before learning the standard written method.

4x3=12

Pupils will learn how to use money confidently, perform calculations and give change accurately.

3x4=12

12÷3=4

They will also learn how to collect, sort and accurately display data and will ask and answer questions about the information presented.

French and British Sign Language

Pupils will follow classroom instructions in French and will also learn the names of colours and classroom objects. They will also learn signs for colours and food, and will continue to use BSL in everyday routines.




Physical Education

Health and Wellbeing



They will now write at greater length across a variety of genres, and we will use the story mountain format to write five-part stories which include an introduction, build up, problem, resolution and ending. Pupils will include dialogue in their stories and will learn to accurately use speech marks. They will also be learning to write accurate instructions and detailed explanations.
