

Numeracy

Our current focus in Numeracy is Multiplication and Division. During this block of work, we will be developing our confidence multiplying and dividing, using both mental and written strategies. We will continue to develop our recall of times tables every day by playing games answering quick-fire verbal questions and by speed writing against the clock!

Learning will then move to Money and Time. When learning about Money, we will combine our knowledge of the four main operations and apply these to solve money-based problems. We will look at both analogue and digital, and 12- and 24-hour time during our Time unit of work.



We will work through these units using a real-life context which will boost our knowledge of solving everyday problems that we might face.

Social Studies

During this term, our class topic will be 'We are all Different'.

We will learn about discrimination and some of the forms it can take within society. We will define and discuss key vocabulary, including racism and disability.



As part of our learning, we will explore key figures, from both the past and present, who have challenged discriminatory behaviours and have proven you can achieve no matter who you are.

Homework is issued on a Monday and is due to be returned to class by Friday. Tasks are issued on Google Classroom, in addition to children having a homework folder and jotter. Activities will include Reading, Spelling, Numeracy and Talking and Listening.

Literacy

This term, Room 6 are reading the Scots novel, 'Geordie's Mingin Medicine'. Through this we will explore Scots language before discussing and translating vocabulary to English to aid our understanding of the text. We will also work on a range of reading activities including summarising, predicting, visualising, and inferring. We will then move on to reading new books and novels within our working groups.

During weekly Taught Writing lessons, our focus will be Information Reports and Explanation texts. In our writing we will work to include a combination of sentence structures, in addition, to having clear and concise structures for our writing pieces as a whole, making sure to always include things such as titles, opening statements and conclusions.

Grammar and spelling inputs will also be a key part of our weekly literacy programme.



This term we will also work in small groups to plan, produce and present a short information talk to the class.
