

Numeracy

Pupils are developing their knowledge of division. They will learn about a range of mental and written strategies which will also involve remainders. They will learn about the link between multiplication and division. We will also be exploring fractions, decimals and percentages. Pupils will develop their knowledge of simple fractions and will begin to familiarise themselves with equivalent fractions. Pupils will be introduced to tenths and they will learn to add and subtract decimals.

We will be learning about time and money. Pupils will learn about counting and ordering money. We will learn to calculate change. In addition, we will apply our learning in addition and subtraction to money. We will learn to read the time and calculate durations.

Science

In Primary 6 pupils will be observing and researching features of our solar system, using simple models to communicate their understanding of size, scale, time and relative motion within it.

Topic

This term we will continue to learn about climate change and the destruction of the rainforests. We will create persuasive letters influenced by this learning. We will be carrying out an enterprise topic during the final term which will link to our previous learning about the rainforest. We will organise a sponsored event and create a small business to raise money for charity. We will develop our teamwork skills, our financial skills and our ICT skills.

Literacy

We will use the context of the rainforest and experiences we share in the final term to inspire this writing. Pupils will focus on improving their use of VCOP in their writing. We will continue to work on our core targets through writing our weekend news.
