Numeracy

This term we are learning about Fractions, Percentages and Decimals

Pupils will be able to:



 Understand the relationship between percentages. fractions and decimals and applying their knowledge help them solve worded problems.

 Develop their understanding of percentages, fractions and decimals by learning: equivalent and simplified fractions. As well as improper and mixed fractions and understanding these concepts in real life scenarios.

Learners should continue to engage with their 'Learn Its' weekly alongside their Numeracy homework. These are based on fractions, decimals and percentages this term.



Health and Wellbeina

Our 'Wellbeing Indicator' focus this term will be Active. Pupils will explore the difference between moderate and vigorous activity. We will also discuss the importance of having a balance of physical activity and rest on our physical, social and emotional health. We will continue to engage with the 'Emotion Works' programme to develop understanding of emotional language.

Cross Country

Our P6 and 7s have the chance to participate in Cross Country training on Mondays and Tuesdays at Kildare Park. Those choosing not to participate in Cross Country will focus on fitness development during outdoor PE and indoor PE slots. Science

This term, pupils will be exploring the characteristics of flowering and non-flowering plants. We will also describe how some plants have adapted to survive in certain environments.

Literacy and Languages

This term, pupils will continue to work through spelling programmes at their appropriate level. They will also be developing their reading skills through group novels. There will be a particular focus on using evidence and direct guotes from the text to justify answers. In writing, pupils will be focusing on creating texts for a range of purposes. They will be focusing on writing in a discursive and persuasive way with opportunities for narrative writing too.

French/ BSL

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Our focus this term will be months and seasons along with asking and answering guestions relating to specific dates, such as birthdays.



Social Studies

The focus of our learning this term is the history of Edinburgh. We will explore the reasons for the Black Plague outbreak and the impact this had on the city and its people. We will take a deep dive into famous stories that have helped shape Edinburgh's history, such as Burke and Hare and Greyfriars Bobby. Additionally, pupils will have the opportunity to develop their expressive art skills with lessons linked to the Edinburgh Fringe and the Military Tattoo.
